Bollheyes, Vintage, Devon (Medium, 6%) Traditional Devon cider matured in oak

Cockeyed, Cockbird, Devon (Sweet, 5%) Sweet clear cider with a full apple taste

Cotswold Cider Co, No Brainer, Oxfordshire (Dry, 6%) Dry hazy, with rich fruity quality

Crafty, Smoak Matured, Devon (Medium/Dry, 6%) Aged and matured in smoked oak barrels

Cranbourne Chase Cider, Traditional Farmhouse, Dorset (Sweet 6%) Matured in oak barrels

Dorset Star, Stargazer, Dorset, (Medium, 5.5%) Medium blend of bitter sweet apples

Hallets, National Treasure, Monmouthshire (Sweet, 5%) Made from a traditional and natural keiving method

Hand Made, Firestarter, Somerset, (Medium/Dry, 6.2%) Soft zingy and refreshing

Harry's Cider, Mango & Lime, Somerset, (Sweet, 4%) Fresh with a citrus kick

Harry's Cider, Raspberry & Blackcurrant, Somerset, (Sweet, 4%) Refreshing fruit combination

Hunts Cider, Wobbler, Devon, (Medium, 6%) Traditional farmhouse still cider

Whitworth, Shipman's Revenge, Monmouthshire, (Medium, 6.5%) Made with ancient abbey apples from Pembrokeshire, and Monmouthshire apples, combined with Broxwood Foxwhelps from west London, fruity with tannins

Lulworth Skipper, Single Variety, Dorset, (Sweet, 6.5%) Made with Yarlinton Mill apples

Napton Cidery, Pig in Pulp, Warwickshire, (Medium/Dry, 7.2%) Medium Dry unique blend with a smooth taste and complex finish

Newton Court, Gaspig Goose, Herefordshire, (Medium, 5.8%) Organic medium, well balanced full bodied

Purbeck, Joes Dry Cider, Dorset, (Dry, 5.6%) Dry refreshing and velvety smooth

Ross-On-Wye, Suzi Wong, Herefordshire, (Medium/Sweet 5.5%) Medium sweet still cider from a blend of apples

Sampford Courtenay, Traditional, Devon, (Sweet, 5%) Slightly sweet with a wonderful rich cider taste

Severn Cider, Farmhouse, Gloucestershire, (Dry, 5.3%) Dry blend of heritage varieties slightly cloudy full bodied

Wise Owl Cider, Traditional, Kent, (Medium, 6%) Bittersweet blend

Celtic Marshes, Craklin Rosie, Herefordshire, (Medium, 5%) Light refreshing delicate perry

Nempnett, Piglet's Perry, Somerset, (Medium/Sweet, 7%) Cloudy straw colour with a floral pear aroma

Olivers, Classic Perry, Herefordshire, (Medium/Sweet, 6%) A straw-bright perry with a spicy rhubarb nose

The Bottle Kicking Cider Company, Cross Farm Perry, Leicestershire, (Medium/Dry, 5%) Subtle pear taste with a dry finish
