

CIDER & Perry List

ABRAHALLS AD 6.5%

This skillfully crafted, still dry cider, is well-rounded and easy to drink. It is made on their Herefordshire farm from 100% cider apples. An intense heady aroma of crushed apples on the nose, natural golden colour, dry but smooth on the palate leaving a clean after taste made from a blend of bitter sweet and sharp cider apples and a smattering of Kingston Black the old cider maker's favourite.

ABRAHALLS LILY THE PINK 4.5%

A medium fruity cider – gorgeous pink colour – made from 100% cider apples on their Herefordshire farm – intense fruity aroma – very drinkable!!!

AMPLEFORTH CIDER 6.5%

Ampleforth Cider, made at Ampleforth Abbey in Yorkshire is a strong, dry cider with a wonderful complex and a very fruity flavour.

BUTFORD ORGANICS – PERRY 6%

Produced by Martin Harris; a Yorkshireman who moved to Herefordshire to start an organic smallholding. Finding that this included an orchard Martin started to make cider and now produces some of the most delightful organic ciders and perries. This Perry is crisp, clear and full of pear flavour. It is naturally quite sweet.

CHANTS BADGERS SPIT 7.5%

Chant's (ex -Naish's) Cider has been made at Piltown Farm, West Pennard - near the Glastonbury Festival site - for 200 years. Their Badgers Spit is a hazy gold, well-balanced dry cider with a tart finish

CIRCLE CIDER – CAT'S TONGUE 6.1%

A hazy dry cider, a true West Country traditional flavour with a bit of sparkle for the modern pallet, light touch of old horse and a touch of astringency to finish as a dry cider should.

CIRCLE CIDER – BUTCHER BOY 7%

A full apple flavour balancing sweetness and acidity which go head to head to be the last flavour you can taste.

CIRCLE CIDER – ROUNDABOUT 5.6%

A bright cider with a sharp apple aroma you would find with a calvados a light fresh fruity flavour leaving a slight dryness on the tongue.

GWYNT Y DDRAIG TWO TREES PERRY 4.5%

This oak aged, Welsh perry is quite clear, has a caramel nose and a dry finish. It is a very lively. A popular Perry that is easy to drink.

HOGANS – PANKING POLE 6.2%

This is a dry cider that gets its name from the long pole used in the orchard to shake the cider apple harvest from the trees. This is a classic golden cloudy cider with typical cider apple bitterness and fruit aromas. Dry on the palate, its complex flavours deliver a strong finish.

HOGANS – POACHERS PERRY 5.8%

A smooth, traditional, medium Perry with a fresh fruity aroma and bitter-sweet finish.

LILLEYS MERRY MONKEY CIDER 4.5%

A medium Somerset scrumpy made with unfiltered bittersweet apples, cloudy honey coloured, full of character with a rich appley flavour.

MOORLANDS FARM – MEDIUM SWEET 6.4%

Rob Gibbon first made cider as a one off but is proved to be so popular that he now produces it on a regular basis along with apple juice. He uses mainly Yorkshire grown apples which give the cider a definitive regional style and a softer taste to West Country ciders where the apples used have a sharper taste with more tannins. This medium sweet cider has a distinctive appley taste with a slightly sweet finish.

OLIVERS - PERRY 6.5%

Tom Oliver, also the tour manager for the band the Proclaimers, produces in Herefordshire excellent easy drinking ciders and perries which are well balanced. Full on with a rich mouth feel and intensity, a still, medium-dry blended Perry.

ONCE UPON A TREE THROWN HAT 5%

A medium Herefordshire cider from Harry Taylor range aptly named from Harry's quote "If an apple tree is pruned well, you can throw your hat through it". Deep golden in colour, bittersweet aromas of apple skin, caramel with an herby note.

ORCHARD PIG EXPLORER 4.5%

Orchard Pig Explorer from Somerset is a soft, medium cider with a clean flavour and a lingering apple finish - eminently drinkable.

ORCHARDS OF HUSTHWAITES GALTRES GOLD 7.5%

A dry clear and strong Yorkshire cider, made nearby, likened to an Apple Riesling!

PURENORTH HAVE N APPLE 4.5%

Made from apples grown in Rob North's Orchards in Holmfirth, Yorkshire this 4.5% medium cider is very easy drinking and has been well received.

PURENORTH SWEET UNION 5.5%

A Medium Sweet Cider made from bitter sweet apples and sweetened with fresh pressed apple juice made from Katy apples. A delicious drink with a full apple flavour.

PURENORTH VALLEY ZEST MEDIUM DRY 7.2%

A real cider drinkers cider! Naturally cloudy very full bodied with a sharp / zesty finish.

ROSS-ON-WYE - ALPACA PERRY 6.5%

A full bodied blend of pears, medium Perry. One of the great producers of the craft cider revival. Cider has been made on the Johnstons' farm in Herefordshire for more than twenty years. Over 70 varieties of apples and pears are grown, all of which are turned into cider or Perry. The Alpaca Perry is named after the apacas who share the field in which the pears for the Perry are grown.

ROSS-ON-WYE -CASK CONDITIONED (W) 6.5%

One of the great producers of the craft cider revival. Cider has been made on the Johnston's Herefordshire farm for more than twenty years. Over 70 varieties of apples and pears are grown, all of which are turned into cider or perry. A great believer in the art of blending, Ross' cider is always a firm favourite. This particular cider has been fermented in old whiskey casks, initially dry with a sweet after taste.

W.M. WATKINS - LAZY DAZE PERRY 5.6%

Tony Watkins began cider production in 2003 in Wales, making 150 gallons. He has steadily increased production and their cider sales now complement their principle business of beef & sheep farming. A medium-sweet, still Perry made from a blend of pear varieties.

WESTCROFTS - JANET'S JUNGLE JUICE 6.5%

Produced by cider maker John Harris in Somerset, Janet's Jungle Juice is a firm favourite with customers. When you try it you will see why it was the CAMRA national award winner in 2008. This medium dry cider is well rounded and fruity with a deep texture and flavour. It is a fantastic starting point for inexperienced cider drinkers as it is so very easy drinking.
